**Open Adoption** (for non-Aboriginal children and young people) provides permanent care for a child or young person who are unable to live with their family. Adopting a child or young person means that all legal rights and responsibilities are transferred from the parents to the adoptive parents.

Open Adoption is the acceptance of the child or young person having more than one family, and a willingness to know about each other, share information and if possible, build relationships.

When a child or young person is placed into your care, we are working together towards a permanent pathway. If restoration is not suitable, then open adoption may be an option.

If it is determined that open adoption is the best permanency pathway for the child or young person, our dedicated team will work with you and your family through the process.

At William Campbell Foundation we are committed to supporting safe homes for life for children and young people. We are looking for carers who want to open up their home to a child to give them a sense of belonging, consistency, routine and care.
